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As the owner and operator of a midsize construction company, we have seen the expense of maintaining our fleet of vehicles and heavy equipment rise significantly in the past few years. This has been primarily due to the increase in gasoline and diesel fuel. Downtime due to mechanical breakdown and unscheduled maintenance contributes to high cost increases as well.

I was asked by management of MotorCheckUp to participate in a pilot program in January of 2007 to test the efficacy of their product on my vehicles and equipment. The testing period lasted through May of 2007. Detailed records were kept as we tested each vehicle and construction engine twice per month.

Overall the results were significant. In several instances, we were able to foresee problems early on - excessive fuel and water in engines, and high levels of contaminants - and maintenance was completed on our schedule. Repairs were low-cost versus what we would have paid for a breakdown, not including downtime.

Additionally, we were able to delay changing the oil in some of our vehicles as the testing showed no contaminants and the oil was in good condition. This aspect alone saved us time and money.

While it is difficult to put an actual dollar value on MotorCheckUp, our fleet and equipment managers will continue to use the product on a twice monthly basis, as we have been doing since the test started (although now we are paying for the product!). I would recommend MotorCheckUp to anyone concerned about their engines or equipment, and I highly value the information the product gives relating to such.
